

**HARRISONBURG ELECTRIC COMMISSION
SCHEDULE 1S1/1W1
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE**

- I. **APPLICABILITY:** This Schedule shall apply to electric service in a single private dwelling and its appurtenances, the major use of which is for lighting and household appliances for the personal comfort and convenience of those residing therein. Private dwelling in which space is occasionally used for the conduct of business by a person residing therein will be served under this rate. Where a portion of a dwelling is used regularly for the conduct of business, the electricity consumed in that portion so used will be separately metered and billed under the General Service Rate; if separate circuits are not provided by the customer, service to the entire premises shall be billed under the General Service Rate. This Schedule shall not apply to service to institutions such as clubs, fraternities, recognized rooming or boarding houses or the space in an apartment or other residential building primarily devoted to use as an office or studio for professional or other gainful purposes.
- II. **CHARACTER OF SERVICE:** Service supplied shall be alternating current single phase, 60 cycles. Voltage supplied will be at the discretion of the Distributor and will be determined by the voltage available from distribution lines in the vicinity and/or other conditions. All services installed will be overhead services unless otherwise provided for.
- III. **MONTHLY RATE**
- a. **Basic Customer Charge**
Basic Customer Charge \$9.50 per billing month
 - b. **Plus kwh Charge**
1S1 For billing months May through October (summer rates):
First 800 kwh @ \$0.08480 per kwh = \$67.84
Excess over 800 kwh @ \$0.09480 per kwh

1W1 For billing months November through April (winter rates):
First 800 kwh @ \$0.08480 per kwh = \$67.84
Excess over 800 kwh @ \$0.06930 per kwh
 - c. Monthly minimum charge will be \$9.50 per billing month.
 - d. Fuel Adjustment: Each kilowatt-hour used is subject to adjustment for charges in fuel costs, provided such fuel costs are charged to the Distributor by its supplier.
 - e. Wholesale Power Adjustment: From time to time the Distributor may charge the Customer for additional wholesale power cost charged the Distributor by its supplier. The charge will be added to each kilowatt-hour purchased by the Customer.
- IV. **BILLING AND PAYMENT:** All bills will be rendered monthly and are due when rendered. If not paid on or before the past due shown on the bill, a 5% delayed payment charge may be added. If payment of bill is received after past due date the delayed payment charge may be included in the next month's bill. Waiver of delayed payment charge can only be made by the Commission, and will be considered only upon written explanation of reason for the request.
- V. **OTHER CHARGES:** Customers supplied under this schedule are subject to deposits, connection charges, fees, taxes, etc. as set forth in Schedule No. 11 of the Distributors Schedule of Rates and Charges.
- VI. **SINGLE-POINT DELIVERY:** The above rates are based upon the supply of service through a single delivery and metering point and at a single voltage. Separate supply for the same Customer at other points of use or a different phase or voltage will be separately metered and billed.
- VII. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** Service under the above rate is subject to the Schedule of Rules and Regulations, as amended, of the Distributor, which constitute a part of these rates.
